Balcombe Region Ecological Vegetation Class Map

This map is based on EVC maps of the modelled distribution of pre-1750 vegetation boundaries (NRE 2002). Less than 10% of native vegetation cover is remaining today within the Balcombe region.

It is intended as a guide for determining the EVC in which you will be planting. For more detailed information regarding the boundaries of EVC's in this area, contact Mornington Peninsula Shire Customer Service.
